- Clean driver's abstract (no at-fault accidents within a 7-year period)

The successful candidate must:

- Complete training program (approximately 5-6 weeks in length, including training for in-car and in-class instruction). Some instructors may opt to provide in-class or in-car instruction only
- Pass a provincial written and driving test for instructors
- Maintain a flexible working schedule: weekday, weekend, and evening hours
- Demonstrate ability to evaluate and record the performance of students and clients
- Demonstrate a positive attitude and provide instruction and in-car interventions in a safe and controlled manner
- Demonstrate the ability to communicate effectively with people between the ages of 16 and 75
